15 “I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. ²Every branch in Me that bears no fruit, He takes away. And every branch that bears fruit, He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. ³You are already clean through the word which I have spoken to you. ⁴Remain in Me, as I also remain in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it remains in the vine, neither can you, unless you remain in Me.

⁵“I am the vine, you are the branches. He who remains in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit. For without Me you can do nothing. ⁶If a man does not remain in Me, he is thrown out as a branch and withers. And they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. ⁷If you remain in Me, and My words remain in you, you will ask whatever you desire, and it shall be done for you. ⁸My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

⁹“As the Father loved Me, I also loved you. Remain in My love. ¹⁰If you keep My commandments, you will remain in My love, even as I have kept My Father’s commandments and remain in His love. ¹¹I have spoken

these things to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full. ¹²This is My commandment: that you love one another, as I have loved you. ¹³Greater love has no man than this: that a man lay down his life for his friends. ¹⁴You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. ¹⁵I no longer call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master does. But I have called you friends, for everything that I have heard from My Father have I made known to you. ¹⁶You did not choose Me, but I chose you, and appointed you, that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that the Father may give you whatever you ask Him in My name. ¹⁷This I command you: that you love one another.

⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not of yourselves. It is the gift of God, ⁹not of works, so that no one should boast. ¹⁰**For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works,** which God prepared beforehand, so that we should walk in them.
