then your light shall rise in obscurity,

¹¹And the LORD shall guide you continually,
and satisfy your soul in drought,
and strengthen your bones;
and you shall be like a watered garden,
and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.
¹²Those from among you shall rebuild the old waste places;
you shall raise up the foundations of many generations;
and you shall be called, the Repairer of the Breach,
the Restorer of Paths in which to Dwell.

Part of Speech: Noun, Feminine

Transliteration: ódin

Phonetic Spelling: (o-deen')

Definition: a birth pang

Usage: the pain of childbirth, acute pain, severe agony, a snare. **5604** *ōdín* – properly, the pain of childbirth (travail); (figuratively) the pain *necessary to open up* (introduce) something new, i.e. to bring in *more*. [5604 (*ōdín*) suggests *intense suffering* (similar to birth pain) – hence, "to suffer greatly, great pain" (*L & N*, 1, 24.87) like "a birth-pang, travail-pain; figuratively, extreme suffering" (*A-S*).]
